General:
 The following rules regulate the legal relation between the participants and the presenter of the event "Breisgau Triathlon". Responsible for the organisation of the event is the club TNB Malterdingen, represented by Marco Wahrheit. For the business relation between TNB Malterdingen (hereinafter known as organiser), only the rules laid down hereafter in the version valid at the time of inscription or its current version are binding, whichever version may be more beneficial for the participant. The organiser does not recognise any other differing rules or regulation unless he has expressly agreed to them in writing.

Rules of the Competition:
 The competition is based on the rules of competition of the German Triathlon Union DTU (including sports rules, presenters' rules, premier league rules, anti-doping rules and judges' rules) as well as the legal order, codes of procedure and disciplinary rules. These rules can be read and consulted in the race office on the day of the competition. With the application, the participant accepts the above-mentioned rules as binding.



These regulations are set in order to guarantee a standardised practice of this sport with equal opportunities for all and are not contestable by law. Adherence to and acceptance of these rules are a prerequisite for taking part in this competition. Each participant is responsible for the technical safety of his/her equipment and has to make sure that the equipment is in accordance to the rules.

Authorization to participate:

Only triathletes of the individual rating are eligible to participate

- a) with a valid starting passport of the respective national triathlon federation
or
- b) with a day license.

The starting documents will only be issued upon presentation of the valid starting pass. A day license can be requested for € 25 upon registration. The daily license fee must be paid together with the entry fee. Relay participants do not need a day license.

Minimum age:

Single starter: 20 years
Relay participant: swimmer 14 years
Cyclist 18 years; Runner 16 years

The minimum age is determined by the year of birth.

Registration:

- a) Registration is to be done by using the online application under:

www.breisgau-triathlon.de

A contract with the organisers does only result **after the fee has been paid into the above-mentioned account** and after the name of the participant appears on the list of starters. The **list of starters** can be consulted on the internet.

- b) Participation is a **personal right** and each participant has to pick up his or her start documents **in person** as well as have a valid starting pass in his/her possession, which will have to be presented at the office or at other checkpoints with the passport or national identification document. Without starting pass, a day license has to be bought.
- c) An **exchange of starting order** is **not possible**. The registration of an athlete can be rejected or a suspension be pronounced if the athlete disturbs the event, behaves in a disturbing manner even before the event or breaks the race rules or if, according to his conduct, it is probable that the athlete will produce disturbances. The organisers reserve the right at all times to reject an athlete's registration or participation because of on-going doping proceedings or a legally binding ban. Furthermore, every breaking of the rules of the race will lead to a disqualification of the participant.
Athletes who are disqualified for obvious fraud will not receive a starter certificate for the next two

Limit of participants:

With a total of 600 starters for the middle and sprint-distance together, the registration will be closed. Max. 20 relays are allowed.

End of registration:

The online registration will close on August 15th 2021 at midnight or before the participant limit has been reached. If there are still starting places, a late registration on August 21st 2021 is possible in the competition office and on Sunday August 22nd 2021 at the car park Ferromatik Milacron.

For athletes who register after August 1st, 2021, no Finisher-Shirt can be guaranteed.

Registration fees incl. starter's fees:

Single starter:

- € 120, if you register by March 31st, 2021
- € 140, if you register until August 15th, 2021
- € 150, for late registration on August 21st/22nd, 2021

Relays:

- € 150, if you register until March 31st, 2021
- € 170, if you register until August 15th, 2021
- € 180, for late registration on August 21st/22nd, 2021

All fees include VAT, license fees and fees for appropriate time recording device, services such as substantial meals during and after the competition, massages, finisher tee-shirt, medical supervision, result list and certificate are included in the registration fee.

Bank service charges have to be paid for by the participant, Bank transfers or checks in Euro only.

Day license:

A day license can be purchased at the price of 25 €. If the start pass is added to the starting documents, the license fee will be refunded. However, if the start pass number is unknown at the time of online registration, "No, start pass requested" can be selected.

If the start pass number is not handed in until the day of the competition, € 25 must be paid when collecting the starting documents.

Cancellations and refunds:

Cancellations must be made in writing (by mail or letter). The following conditions apply for the reimbursement of the starting money:

If you cancel until August 01st, 2021: refund starting fee minus € 25

In case of cancellation after 01st August 2021, no refund will be given. Any bank charges will be charged to the participant. The participant reserves the right to prove that the organizer has suffered less or no damage by signing out.

Pasta party:

Each Athlete will receive a voucher for the Noodle Party with the start documents. This must be delivered to the noodle dispenser. For companions, additional bons à € 6.50 are available at the competition office. Drinks against payment at the catering counter.

Location: In the finish area, sports ground, Malterdingen

Time: Saturday, August 21st, 2021, from approximately 18:30h

Disclaimer - Limitation of liability:

If the organiser is allowed to modify the implementation or cancel the race because of major force or has to change or cancel the race because of official orders or security reasons, there is no liability for damages on the part of the organiser. A full refund of the entry fee is only possible if the cancellation of the race lies within the responsibility of the organiser. If the event is cancelled due to major force or is the organiser not responsible for the cancellation, the entry fee will be refunded minus the expenditure of the organiser. It is up to the participant to prove that the expenditure of the organiser is lower.

The organizer is not liable for the slightly negligent infringement of the obligations stated in the preceding sentences.

The foregoing limitations on liability do not apply in case of injury to life, body and health. The organizer accepts no liability for objects kept free of charge.

If the organizer has to make changes in the performance of the event due to force majeure or due to an administrative order or for reasons of security or for reasons of security, the Organizer shall not be liable to pay compensation to the participant. Reimbursement of the full start fee requires the complete failure of the event to fall within the responsibility of the organizer. If the event is canceled due to force majeure or the organizer is not responsible for the event, the start fee will be reimbursed, taking into account the expenses of the event organizer. The participant reserves the right to prove that the organizer's expenses are lower.

Age groups and evaluation: The transition area
According to the Union's sports rules, participation is only possible for persons born in or before 2001
M = Male, F = Female.
Year of birth is relevant.

M/F 25-29	year of birth 1996 until 1992
M/F 30-34	year of birth 1991 until 1987
M/F 35-39	year of birth 1986 until 1982
M/F 40-44	year of birth 1981 until 1977

M/F 50-54	year of birth 1971 until 1967
M/F 55-59	year of birth 1966 until 1962
M/F 60-64	year of birth 1961 until 1957
M/F 65-69	year of birth 1956 until 1952
M/F 70-74	year of birth 1951 until 1947
M/F 75 +	year of birth 1946 and older

Every age group with at least three participant will be evaluated.

Relay evaluation:

Each relay team consists of one swimmer, one cyclist and one runner. The first change will take place in a special cycling park which will be marked accordingly. The second change to the runner will also take place in a special area. The starting numbers of the relay team members will differ from the rest of the field. The race briefing, the start, the final provisioning and the victory ceremony are consistent with the other regulations. There will be men, women and mixed team relays. For the first three teams, there will be non-cash prizes. Relay team members have to be at least 18 years of age on the day of the competition.

Material and cash prizes:

With 400 starters and more, there are material and cash prizes worth a total of approx. € 3,000. If the registration number is below 400 starters, the prize money must be adjusted downwards!

Prize money (only single starter)

Women 1st - 5th place,
Men 1st - 10th place.

Material prizes:

Single starters: 1st - 3rd place in the age groups.
Relays 1st - 3rd place

Handing out of the transition bags:

The **Red** (run) and **Green** (after-race) change bags must be handed over to the respective vehicles before the bike check-in. The bags are brought by the organizer to the transition area bike-run or to the finish and will be sorted there.

Time limits / Finish:

Swimming: 1 hour, 10 minutes.

Swimming + cycling: 4 hours, 30 minutes

Finish time: 6 hours, 45 minutes (about 4:45 pm)

Finish bike: Transition zone bike to run, Malterdingen

Finish Run: Sports ground, Malterdingen

Victory ceremony:

From 17.00 h in the finish area, Clubhouse at the sports
ground, Malterdingen.

Bike park (at transition area bike/run)

The bike park is guarded until 17:30 h.

The bicycles can only be handed out to the participant on presentation of the starting number and the athletes' band.

Time recording:

The time recording device system will be provided by the organizer. Other privately used systems are not permitted, thus, all time recording devices will be lent by the organizer.

Time recording chips should be handled carefully. In case of loss, the competitor will assume liability. The fee for the loss of the time recording chip is 50€. The participant itself is in charge of the time recording. The time recording chip has to be worn during the race according to the organizer's requirements.

Provisions:

During and after the competition the participants will be adequately provided with food. After the competition there



will be food and drink in the finish area. The participants are allowed to deposit their own food and drink at the designated points at the nutrition points. This has to be done either by the participant or by an assistant.

Support and medical care:

At the start and in transition area 1 at the Müllersee, Riegel as well as at the finish at the center of Malterdingen, there is an ambulant service point. An additional mobile emergency doctor will provide medical and emergency services at the bike track.

Other rules for participation:

Swimming: The swim will take place in the Müllersee, Riegel.

- a) It is obligatory to wear the bathing caps handed out by the organiser.
- b) Wetsuits are allowed under the following circumstances:
Mandatory at water temperatures between 14,0 °C and 15,9 °C.
Allowed at temperatures between 16.0 and 24.5 °C
Should water temperatures be higher than 24,5°C, the wearing of a wetsuit will not be allowed.

Cycling: The bike ride takes a circular route through Malterdingen and the surrounding communities.

- a) Drafting is forbidden. Relevant for drafting is a drafting box of at least 3 x 12 metres centred behind the bike of each participant. Continuously biking next to another participant is forbidden and will be followed by disqualification. Penalties/suspensions will be served in penalty boxes on the road. Details will be given during the race briefing.
- b) The cycle track is closed to traffic. In a few areas there is a special permit for other road users in the driving direction of the race. Despite blocking, the road traffic regulations and the right to drive are valid.
- c) Each participant has to wear a bike helmet with chin strap approved by a renowned testing institute.
- d) The upper body of the participants has to be covered all the time.
- e) The bibs given out with the starting documents have to be displayed on the bikes and helmets.
- f) The bib has to be worn on the back of the jersey.
- g) The brake handles have to point towards the back.
- h) The helmets have to be placed with the bikes and be handed in with the bike at the bike check-in.

Running: On streets and paths of the municipality Malterdingen, which are completely closed to traffic.

- a) It is not allowed for non-participants to accompany participants.
- b) The upper body of the participants has to be covered all the time.
- c) The bib has to be worn at the front of the jersey.

General:

- a) Each participant is responsible for his or her split and overall time recording. The time recording chip has to be worn throughout the race according to the requirements of the organisers.
- b) Instructions by organisers, doctors and emergency medical services are to be obeyed.
- c) Modification of bibs such as scaling down or others is not allowed.
- d) Protests will only be taken into account in written form and with a deposit of 25€ according to the DTU sports order.
- e) In return for the time recording device and after showing the bib, the bikes can be checked out at transition area 2.
- f) Each participant receives three change bags in different colors:
 - **Blue** (Bike): The blue bag must be placed at the bag stand at the lake by 9:50 am.
 - **Red** (Run): The red is to be delivered before 9.45 clock on the truck before the bike check-in. It is brought to the change zone bike/run by the organizer.
 - **Green** (Afterrace - Pre / Post-weather clothing). The green bag is to be delivered before 9.45 clock on the truck before the bike check-in. It is brought to the finish area by the organizer.
- g) The organizer reserves himself the right for short-term changes.
- h) The timing transponders are collected immediately after the finish by assistants.
